

SpiraTeam[®] v4.2 Release Notes

SpiraTeam[®] version 4.2 is the next release of the SpiraTeam[®] integrated application lifecycle management system from Inflectra[®]. These Release Notes cover what issues this version addresses, what new features have been added, and finally download instructions. New Features

- Ability to have artifact dependencies and associate tasks to incidents
- Enhanced source code inspection and traceability capabilities including multiple-branch support
- Refreshed Planning Board for Scrum, Kanban and other agile methodologies
- Requirements burndown, burnup and velocity graphs added
- Build details now includes consolidated list of affected artifacts on one screen

Enhancements and Resolved Issues

- Code preview and syntax coloring added to source code file viewing pages
- Test automation user interface improved when using Rapise automated test cases
- Task burndown and burnup graphs updated to better visualize the information
- Assigning a requirement to a release/iteration automatically associates any linked test cases
- Associations grids and reports now include the artifact status as an additional field
- List custom properties can now be categorized as active / inactive and an undelete option has been added
- Components are now available for categorizing tasks and incidents as well as requirements
- Performance enhancements when viewing lots of project documents and using nested linked test steps
- Copying a project now copies the tasks associated with the requirements
- Ability to rank backlog items in the updated Scrum/Kanban planning boards
- Dates in reports standardized to all display in user's local timezone rather than a mix of local and UTC
- Use case scenario steps added to requirements reports
- Additional functions added to both the SOAP and REST web service APIs
- Incident dashboard widgets can now use either Detected Release or Resolved Release for displaying data
- Sorting fixed on main project administration screen.
- Build dropdown list now correctly populates on various report configuration screens
- Rich-text custom properties now render correctly in the various reports

Download Instructions

To obtain this version of SpiraTeam[®], you need to log in to the customer area of the Inflectra[®] Website at: <u>http://www.inflectra.com/CustomerArea</u>. From there you can find the list of downloads under "My Downloads". Simply rightclick on the installation link, download the Microsoft Installer (.msi) package to your computer, and then double-click on the package to begin the installation.

The installer will detect the existing version on your computer (if any) and upgrade the program files and migrate your data into the new version. As always, we recommend that you backup your database and attachments prior to installation.
